Councillor Costidell stated that she had had numerous complaints regarding the state of the play area, requested that we find out where we are on the list and request that Flintshire County Council prioritise accordingly. Clerk to contact Trefor Roberts to request where we are on the list.

Councillor Wrench expressed concerns as she was asked to sign cheques during the summer recess regarding the work done by the Environmental Group. Clerk stated that he had cancelled 2 cheques and had to write 3 cheques in their place. Members felt that Environmental Group need to have their own bank account and that the Community Council would then give an annual grant towards the group.

Councillor Wright stated that there was scaffolding around the school, noted that the flat roof had been done, boiler had been done and the electrical work. Church will have new furniture and new carpets in place ready for songs of praise programme. Best Kept Village gave the village a good bill of health and that the village overall was clean and tidy. Councillor Wright stated that we had not received the Annual Review also requested that the Clerk send the agenda and minutes out earlier so that members would have plenty of time to read before the meeting.
